A person of Cuban, Mexican, Puerto Rican, South or Central American, or other Spanish culture or origin regardless of race








# U.S. Population Growth by Hispanic Origin: 2000 to 2011















#### Percent of Population Hispanic or Latino: 2011

### U.S. Hispanic Population (in millions) by State: 2011






### Numeric Change in Hispanic Population by State: 2000 to 2011






### Percent Change in Hispanic Population by State: 2000 to 2011










### **Largest Detailed Hispanic Origin Group by State: 2010**




